INT. TUCKER CARLSON TONIGHT STUDIO - NIGHT

CECILY

CUT BACK TO:

INT. TUCKER CARLSON TONIGHT STUDIO - CONTINUOUS

JOHN MULANEY

PUNKIE

Thanks Tom I'm standing outside historic Lambeau Field which is normally home of the Packers but that does not seem to be the case tonight. As we've spotted thousands and thousands of mostly female San Francisco fans in attendance, mixed in with a few theatre critics as well. I'm joined by two 49er faithfuls who traveled all the way to Wisconsin to be here tonight.

ANDREW

Yeah hi. I've been a 49ers fan ever since I can remember. I always ride or die with my team. But ever since the 9ers traded for Jimmy, Grandma has become like his *biggest* fan.

CHLOE

That's right, yes.

ANDREW

She used to hate sports. But now,
she never misses a game!

CHLOE

Listen, I never see a game of
football in my life. But when my
grandson show me picture of Mr.
Garoppolo, now I no miss a game.
Dis is the most beautiful man I
ever seen in my life. My husband
and I we marry for 50 years. I see
picture of Jimmy Garoppolo on my

CHLOE

Very nice life I make. But then I

PUNKIE

CHLOE

Punkie hands Chloe a picture on her phone.

CHLOE (CONT'D)

CUT BACK TO:

INT. SPORTS NEWS STUDIO - CONTINUOUS

James attempts to stay cool. John doesn't.

JAMES

Well as always thank you Kathleen.
And try to stay warm out there.

JOHN MULANEY

It's probably warm in Jimmy G's
bed. Maybe Kathleen tries to find
out where that is for us?

JAMES

Let's talk about his play please?

JOHN MULANEY

He could play like dog crap and I'd
still let him hit it on a week day.

JAMES

Josh...

JOHN MULANEY

Garoppolo, that's got to be Italian
right? I mean, Garrrrrapollo
Garroppoloo Garrrrrrrrrr...

JAMES

Guys why don't we cut to Brittney's
interview after their last week's
win against the Cowboys?

SAN FRANCISCO 49ERS PRESS CONFERENCE - VIDEO

* A REAL VIDEO PLAYS OF JIMMY GAROPPOLO ANSWERING A
REPORTER'S QUESTION. HE THEN POINTS TO SOMEONE IN THE
AUDIENCE AND SAYS "ONE MORE QUESTION". CUTS TO MELISSA,

COMMERCIAL PARODY: \$10 FOR KIDS

Heidi Gardner, Natalie Portman, and Cecily Strong.

INT. TOY STORE - DAY / INT. KITCHEN - DAY

NATALIE PORTMAN, browses through a toy store while on the phone with her friend, HEIDI.

HEIDI

You're still coming to Stephanie's birthday party right?

NATALIE PORTMAN

Yup! What exactly is she into?

STEPHANIE, Heidi's 9 year old daughter, runs around the home.

HEIDI

STEPHANIE DROP IT!

(to Natalie Portman)

Sorry, let me call you back.

Heidi hangs up. Natalie Portman looks panicked as she continues to look around the store. We hear a CECILY'S voice.

CECILY (V.O.)

Shopping for your friend's weird kid? The one who sucks? She's the reason your friend doesn't go out anymore right?

NATALIE PORTMAN

(looking around)

Is she too old for a Barbie? Does she like to read?

CECILY (V.O.)

What if there was a gift that's guaranteed to make any kid happy.

Natalie Portman nods her head at the camera. She then sees something on the shelf and reaches to pick it up.

CECILY (V.O.)

Introducing \$10 for Kids! The perfect gift for that perfect... whoever!

Natalie Portman picks up a beautiful box labeled "\$10 for Kids" with a \$10 dollar bill in it. She smiles.

CECILY (V.O.)
\$10 for Kids is the hottest new
gift that's great for both boys and
girls. Cause these days, "little
Sammy" could mean anything!

EXT. SUBURBAN BACKYARD - DAY

Natalie Portman confidently walks with her wrapped gift
through Stephanie's birthday party while kids run around.

CECILY (V.O.)
\$10 for Kids is perfect for
occasions such as birthday parties,
recitals, "You were very well
behaved at Nana's funeral", "Thanks
for going potty without freaking
out this time!", and of course,
"Don't worry, I'm a cool stepdad".

Heidi waves at Natalie Portman and pushes Stephanie towards
her.

NATALIE PORTMAN
Happy birthday Sydney!

STEPHANIE
Stephanie -

NATALIE PORTMAN
Stephanie! This is for you!

Natalie Portman hands her the gift. Stephanie unwraps it.

HEIDI
(in the distance)
Say thank you sweetie!

Stephanie examines the gift. She's confused.

STEPHANIE
What is this?

CECILY (V.O.)
It's \$10 for Kids!

STEPHANIE
What's it like... do?

NATALIE PORTMAN
It's really cool actually. With \$10
for Kids, you can buy anything you
want!

STEPHANIE

Oh, like a house?!

NATALIE PORTMAN

Well no, not like a house. But like maybe a doll house!

STEPHANIE

So why didn't you just get me a doll house?

CECILY (V.O.)

Cause doll houses are expensive and boring! \$10 for Kids is way more practical.

NATALIE PORTMAN

This could be used for anything you want! So maybe you could put this money away to help you buy a doll house in the future!

STEPHANIE

So you got me like... on the path to get a doll house one day?

NATALIE PORTMAN

I mean, you can get other cool stuff with it too! Like candy!

STEPHANIE

I don't like candy.

NATALIE PORTMAN

Oh ok. Do you like books?

STEPHANIE

Not really...

They stand there awkwardly. Heidi walks by.

HEIDI

(to Stephanie)

Did you say thank you for the...
(looking at the gift)
\$10?

CECILY (V.O.)

For Kids!

HEIDI

Why didn't you just get her like a gift card or something?

CECILY (V.O.)
UGH cause everyone gets a gift
card! She doesn't get it.

STEPHANIE
A gift card would have been better.

NATALIE PORTMAN
I DON'T KNOW I'M NOT GOOD AT GIVING
GIFTS TO CHILDREN OK!!!

Awkward beat. Heidi looks scared.

HEIDI
Just say thank you Stephanie...

STEPHANIE
No!

NATALIE PORTMAN
Well then maybe I should just march
on back to the toy store and get my
\$30 back!

HEIDI
Wait, this cost you \$30, for a \$10
dollar bill?!

NATALIE PORTMAN
Yeah, I don't know. It came in like
nice packaging.

CECILY (V.O.)
Don't listen to them! They don't
love you like I do!

NATALIE PORTMAN
(looking up)
They don't?

STEPHANIE
Mom, who is she talking to?

Natalie breaks down and cries. Heidi shuffles Stephanie away
as everyone stares at Natalie. The party is ruined.

A graphic appears of \$10 for Kids.

CECILY (V.O.)
It's \$10 for Kids! Because \$10 is
about right. Right?

END.

TOPICAL SKETCH: IT'S BEREAL TIME

Bowen Yang, Melissa Villaseñor, Chris Redd, David Harbour,
and James Austin Johnson.

INT. 7-ELEVEN - DAY

A 7-Eleven is being robbed by two people in ski masks. BOWEN
and MELISSA, two customers, lie face down across the room.
Dramatic music can be heard.

Bowen gets a notification on his phone. He looks down at it.

BOWEN
Oh, God. Not now...

MELISSA
What? What is it?!

BOWEN
It's BeReal time.

Melissa sees the **BeReal app** on his phone. Music intensifies.

MELISSA
I don't know what that is.

BOWEN
BeReal's this awesome new social
media app that my friends made me
get. I got it ironically at first,
but now I'm *obsessed* with it.

Across the room, CHRIS, one of the robbers, threatens a
customer.

CHRIS
MONEY NOW!

BOWEN
(to Melissa)
You take photos and post them so
your friends can see. It's so cool.

MELISSA
Isn't that just Instagram?

BOWEN
It's nothing like Instagram. These
photos disappear after one day.

MELISSA
Oh, so it's like Snapchat.

BOWEN
 (getting annoyed)
 Oh my God you're not even
 listening. It takes a photo from
 the front *and* the back camera.

Bowen takes a selfie with Melissa. The two robbers hear the sound the camera makes and storm over to Bowen.

CHRIS
 (picks Bowen up)
 DID YOU JUST TAKE A PICTURE OF US?!

BOWEN
 NO I DIDN'T! NOT A PICTURE!
 (calm)
 I took a BeReal.

CHRIS
 A Be... what?

BOWEN
 A *BeReal*. It's this awesome new
 social media app. You gotta get it.
 It really is for everybody.

Chris sees himself in the 2nd BeReal photo.

CHRIS
 WE'RE IN THAT PICTURE! YOU LIED!

BOWEN
 I'M SORRY I ONLY HAD TWO MINUTES!

CHRIS
 What? Why only two?

BOWEN
 YOU ONLY HAVE TWO MINUTES TO POST!
 IT'LL LET YOU POST AFTER THAT, BUT
 EVERYONE WILL KNOW YOU POSTED LATE!

CHRIS
 So?!

BOWEN
 SOOO, EVERYONE WILL COMMENT "LATE"
 AND THEN THEY'LL STOP INVITING YOU
 OUT AS MUCH BECAUSE THEY THINK
 YOU'RE NOT INTO BEREAL! BUT YOU
 ARE! YOU ARE INTO BEREAL, YOU WERE
 JUST IN THE SHOWER, THAT'S ALL!

Chris points his gun at Bowen.

CHRIS

Delete this now, or else.

BOWEN

If I delete it, I'll have to take another BeReal. And everyone will know I retook my BeReal because it says so on the app. So it might just be less humiliating to kill me.

Suddenly, Bowen gets a notification that someone named Tom posted. The picture is of Robber #2 robbing the 7-Eleven.

BOWEN (CONT'D)

Oh my God, Tom?

The second robber takes off his mask. He's revealed to be DAVID HARBOUR, an old friend of Bowen's.

DAVID HARBOUR

Hey Greg, I didn't realize you were in town. I love your BeReal by the way.

CHRIS

(to David Harbour)

You're on this app too?

BOWEN

Everyone's on BeReal.

MELISSA

(still on the floor)

I'm sorry, are you guys like sponsors for them or something?

BOWEN

No, I wish though!

DAVID HARBOUR

If you like know someone who is, I'd love to give you my number. I love BeReal. I'm Team Real.

BOWEN

I'm Team Real too.

DAVID HARBOUR

Awesome.

Suddenly, police lights flash from outside. JAMES speaks through a megaphone.

CHRIS
 (to Melissa)
 You called the cops didn't you!

MELISSA
 No oh my God I swear!

JAMES (O.S.)
 She didn't. It's Luke. I saw your
 BeReal Greg and recognized the 7-
 Eleven. Cause as you know, BeReal
 takes a picture from the front and
 back camera.

DAVID HARBOUR
 Don't I know it!

BOWEN
 Oh my God, Luke from Seton Hall?

JAMES (O.S.)
 I didn't realize you were in town!

BOWEN
 We gotta catch up sometime. Let me
 give you my number after this.

DAVID HARBOUR
 BeReal really has a special way of
 bringing people together.

Chris grabs Melissa and points his gun at her.

CHRIS
 Let me go, or else.

Melissa screams. Music intensifies as everyone looks around.
 Suddenly, David Harbour shoots Chris, killing him. There's
 blood all over Melissa's face.

BOWEN
 But Tom, he was your friend.

DAVID HARBOUR
 He wasn't Team Real.

BOWEN
 No. No he wasn't.

JAMES (O.S.)
 Sorry, I had like 15 seconds left
 so I had to post. I heard gun
 shots, everything cool?

DAVID HARBOUR
Yeah, the good guys won.

MELISSA
(seeing the blood)
AHHHHHHHHHH!

DAVID HARBOUR
Team Real!

BOWEN
Team Real!

A graphic of BeReal appears on screen as a VOICE OVER speaks.

VOICE OVER
BeReal! 2 minutes to post, no
matter what.

END.

CHLOE IS CRAY

Chloe Fineman, Colin Jost, Chris Redd, Ego Nwodim, Cecily Strong, Kenan Thompson, John Higgins, Jake Novak, Melissa Villaseñor, Heidi Gardner, and Pete Davidson.

CHLOE TALKING HEAD

CHLOE

After being on SNL for a few years now, I finally feel at home. It was rough with COVID and being the new kid in Studio 8H, but it really toughened me up. You know?

INT. STUDIO 8H HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

CHLOE looks at a wall of the photos of past and present cast members. She runs her hand through the pictures, purposely causing the photos to drop one by one onto the floor.

CHLOE TALKING HEAD

CHLOE

A show week can be stressful, but I'm able to find my moments of Zen.

INT. STUDIO 8H HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

Chloe chugs a handle of vodka. NBC Pages watch in horror.

CHLOE

Let's just get this over with.

She throws the vodka on the floor and walks past COLIN.

CHLOE (V.O.)

I'm not a princess comedian. Princesses don't get shit done.

COLIN

Hey Chloe, I have the notes for that "Puppy Terrorist" sketch you wrote. I'm a little worried it might be offensive to... everyone?

Chloe shoves him to the ground and leaves. CHRIS walks over.

CHRIS

How many sketches am I in tomorrow?

COLIN

This season we're really trying to incorporate the whole cast -

CHRIS

Help yourself up then.

Chris walks over Colin instead of helping him up.

CHLOE TALKING HEAD

CHLOE

This year we have a few new cast members joining the show. I remember how nervous I was my first year, so I really try to go out of my way to help them.

INT. STUDIO 8H HALLWAY - LATER

All the new cast members stand by their dressing rooms. Chloe pours gasoline into the rooms and lights them on fire.

CHLOE

Don't ever take my screen time.

The new members shake in fear. EGO watches from the back.

EGO

This is why I didn't join a sorority in college.

CHLOE TALKING HEAD

CHLOE

Writers are really the backbone of the show. They support us in so many ways and *truly* lift us up.

INT. CHLOE'S DRESSING ROOM - LATER

Chloe is sitting on two writers as she sips coffee. She places it on another writer's head.

CHLOE

Sorry, where are my manners.

Chloe puts a coaster between the cup of coffee and the writer's head. Suddenly, CECILY opens her door.

CECILY
Hey, have you met the new guy yet?

CHLOE
Yeah, everyone seems chill.

CECILY
No like the *new*, new guy. Lorne
just met with a TikToker and hired
him on the spot.

Chloe spits out her coffee into a writer's face.

CHLOE
WHAT?!

CECILY
Apparently because we added one so
late, Lorne said he might cut a
cast member. Too many cooks in the
kitchen I guess. Oh, and don't use
writers as furniture. Not cool.

CHLOE
Sorry...

CECILY
Everyone knows you get that when
you've been on the show for 10
years. Isn't that right Kenan?

CECILY
I'm gonna get me one of those
Please Don't Destroy boys.

John Higgins overhears and sprints away.

CHLOE TALKING HEAD

CHLOE
I certainly wouldn't think of a
TikToker as a threat.

INT. CHLOE'S DRESSING ROOM - NIGHT

Chloe has the TikToker kidnapped in her dressing room. We hear him crying underneath the bag on his head.

CHLOE
Keep your voice down!

Chloe takes off the bag to reveal JAKE NOVAK, the TikToker whose SNL song went viral.

JAKE NOVAK
(crying)
I just wanna be the next SNL cast member...

CHLOE
No you don't.
(whispers in his ear)
You don't wanna see me everyday.

MELISSA & HEIDI TALKING HEAD

MELISSA
I heard she can get people canceled with the snap of a finger.

HEIDI
They say coke hasn't been around SNL since the 70s. But somebody should tell that to Chloe Fineman!

PETE TALKING HEAD

PETE DAVIDSON
Why do you think I left? She's crazy. And I would know, *I'm crazy*.

CHLOE TALKING HEAD

CHLOE
We're really one big family. Can't wait for another amazing season!

CAMERAMAN
Cut! That's great, thanks Chloe.

Chloe stands and exits. The camera zooms out to reveal she was sitting on top of an out of breath NBC Page.
